



"PayPay" smartphone payment service now available at MYSTAYS Hotel Group Adopted at all 89 facilities within Japan to improve our customer experience and operations

MYSTAYS Hotel Management (Headquarters: Minato-ku, Tokyo, President: Atsuki Asano, hereafter referred to as "MYSTAYS") has introduced smartphone payment service PayPay, offered by PayPay Corporation, a joint venture of Softbank Corp. and Yahoo! Japan.

In addition to "Alipay" (since November 2017), and "WeChat Pay" (since July 2018), which we have already introduced for our Chinese tourists, we aim to improve the customer experience and support cashless on-site operations.

The smartphone payment service "PayPay" service is available at all 89 hotels of MYSTAYS Hotel Group within Japan. This includes "Art Hotel", "Hotel MYSTAYS Premier", "Hotel MYSTAYS", "Flexstay", "MyCUBE by MYSTAYS", "MYSTAYS Premier Residence", "Monthly Resist Stays", and "MYSTAYS Collection".

How to use smartphone payment service "PayPay" at MyStays Hotel Group

Supports the "user scan" method where the user scans a QR code presented by the hotel, using an application.
